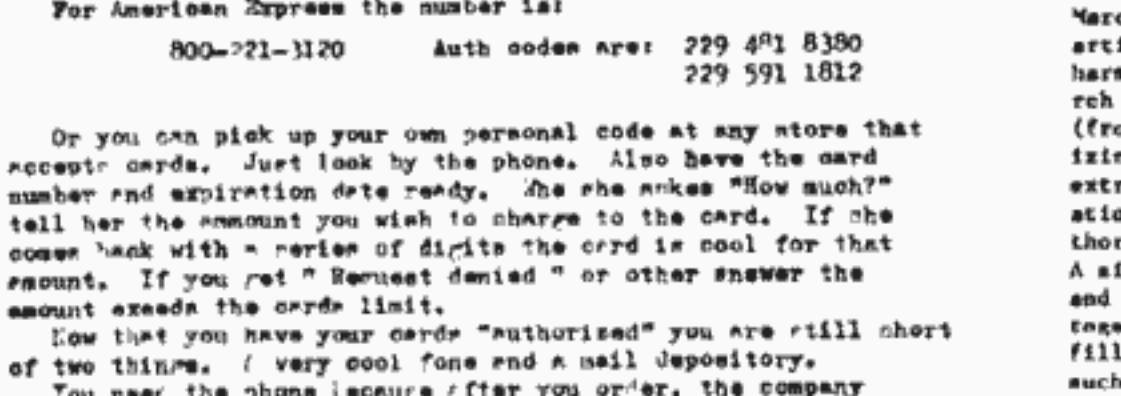
FRESH GARBAGE. Ever run across any meth that smelled like roses? I may speculate that the flowery aroma is due to the product being cut with "Fruit Fresh".

Open Senamese

Many of the combination locks on the market today can be opened with a simple tool made from a piece of .005" spring steel that is gotten from an automotive feeler gauge.

Any lock that has multiple combination wheels is operable by this method. The most notable brand is the Senamese combination lock.



The steel should be heat treated a bit to the brittle side so that the feelers will not become flat during use.

To use insert the feeler between the combination wheel and the lock wall and turn the wheel until you find a notch in the side of the wheel.

This method can be varied to open most multi-wheel combination locks.
